SUBJECT: STATE OF EMERGENCY IN COLUSA COUNTY

As a result of the Ranch and River Fires, collectively called the Mendocino Complex Fire, that began burning in Mendocino and Lake counties on July 27, 2018, Governor Edmund G. Brown, Jr. declared a State of Emergency on November 30, 2018, for Colusa County.

The Mendocino Complex Fire spread into Colusa County on July 31, 2018, causing significant damage to roadways and other critical infrastructure. Additionally, these fires incurred extraordinary costs associated with damaged public infrastructure, debris removal, and other emergency protective measures.

The circumstances of these fires, by reason of its magnitude, are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of any single local government and require the combined forces of a mutual aid region or regions to combat.

As a result of the State of Emergency declared for Colusa County, the Department of Developmental Services (Department) is authorizing, pursuant to Title 17, California Code of Regulations section 54326 (a)(11), regional centers to pay vendors for absences that are the direct result of these fires in the county listed above. The applicable regulation section reads as follows:

[All vendors shall...] Not bill for consumer absences for nonresidential services. The Department shall authorize payment for absences which are the direct result of situations and/or occurrences for which a State of Emergency has been declared by the Governor. If payment for absences due to a State of Emergency is authorized by the Department, the vendor shall bill only for absences in excess of the average number of absences experienced by the vendor during the 12-month period prior to the month in which the disaster occurred.
