SUBJECT: STATE OF EMERGENCY IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

On July 4, 2019, Governor Gavin Newsome declared a State of Emergency for Kern County, as a result of the magnitude 6.4 earthquake centered near the City of Ridgecrest in Kern County. On July 5, 2019, a 7.1 earthquake caused significant damage throughout the region, including neighboring San Bernardino County. On July 5, 2109, Governor Gavin Newsom declared a State of Emergency for San Bernardino County.

This earthquake, caused widespread and significant damage to critical infrastructure, including roads, water lines, gas lines, and multiple structural fires.

The circumstances of this earthquake, by reason of its magnitude, are beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of any single local government and require the combined forces of a mutual aid region or regions to combat.

As a result of the State of Emergency declared for the county listed above, the Department of Developmental Services (Department) is authorizing, pursuant to Title 17, California Code of Regulations section 54326 (a)(11), regional centers to pay vendors for absences that are the direct result of these earthquakes in the county listed above. The applicable regulation section reads as follows:

“ [All vendors shall...] Not bill for consumer absences for nonresidential services. The Department shall authorize payment for absences which are the direct result of situations and/or occurrences for which a State of Emergency has been declared by the Governor. If payment for absences due to a State of Emergency is authorized by the Department, the vendor shall bill only for absences in excess of the average number of absences experienced by the vendor during the 12-month period prior to the month in which the disaster occurred.”
