What Employment Options Are Available?

Support for finding a job or developing a business such as a micro-enterprise can be achieved through the IPP process. Employment can take many forms in the community including Supported Employment, Work Activity Programs and Vocational Training/Habilitation.

Adults who wish to become employed may be eligible for Supported Employment Services. Supports could include a job coach, transportation, assistive technology, specialized job training, and supervision. The decision about whether or not supported employment is the right service is made by the planning team. The adult, his or her Service Coordinator, the Department of Rehabilitation, and other members of the planning team work together to come up with an agreement about the supports that might be most helpful. Supported employment can be done in either individual or group settings, depending upon the needs and skills of the person. Work Activity and Vocational Training Programs offer paid work in a sheltered or center-based workshop setting. Micro-Enterprise is a small business venture that reflects the unique skills and talents of the person.

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就業

有哪些就業方式？

可以透過IPP流程獲得尋找工作，或者創業（例如創辦小微企業）所需的支援。社區就業形式豐富多彩，包括輔助就業、工作活動計畫與職業培訓/適應訓練。

希望就業的成人可以接受輔助就業服務。支援形式可能包括職業指導、交通、輔助技術、專業崗位培訓與監督。由規劃組確定輔助就業是否為正確的方式。成人及其社工、康復科、以及規劃部的其他人士，就可能最有用的支援合作起草協議。可以單獨或集體實施輔助就業，取決於相關人士的需求與技能。工作活動與職業培訓計畫提供室內或區域中心內部工作室的有償工作。微型企業是一種小型企業，彰顯相關人士的獨特技能與才華。
