

# REGISTERING TO VOTE: THE FIRST STEP

**Voting is one of our most important rights and tools as citizens to make our voices heard.** Registering to vote is a crucial first step to cast your vote. Even if you've voted before, make sure to check your registration status is up to date.

You may register to vote in L.A. County if you are:

- A citizen of the United States.
- At least 18 years of age or older on or before Election Day.
- Not found mentally incompetent by a court of law.

## Registering to vote is easy!

Registering to vote online only takes a couple of minutes! Check your registration status and register to vote at [plan.lavote.net](http://plan.lavote.net). You can also register to vote in-person at your local DMV or by mail. No matter which way you choose, you must do so by **October 19th to be mailed a Vote by Mail ballot.**

To register online, you'll need:

- Your California driver's license or California identification card number
- The last four digits of your social security number
- Your date of birth
