## FAIR HEARING

Californians with developmental disabilities, particularly people of color, find the process to appeal decisions by their regional centers very difficult. The "Fair Hearing" system is very confusing, complex, and biased. Fair Hearing is the process for resolving disagreements between the regional center and the consumer of the regional center. You have a right to appeal. We provide an overview on the process of a fair hearing and what your rights are.
